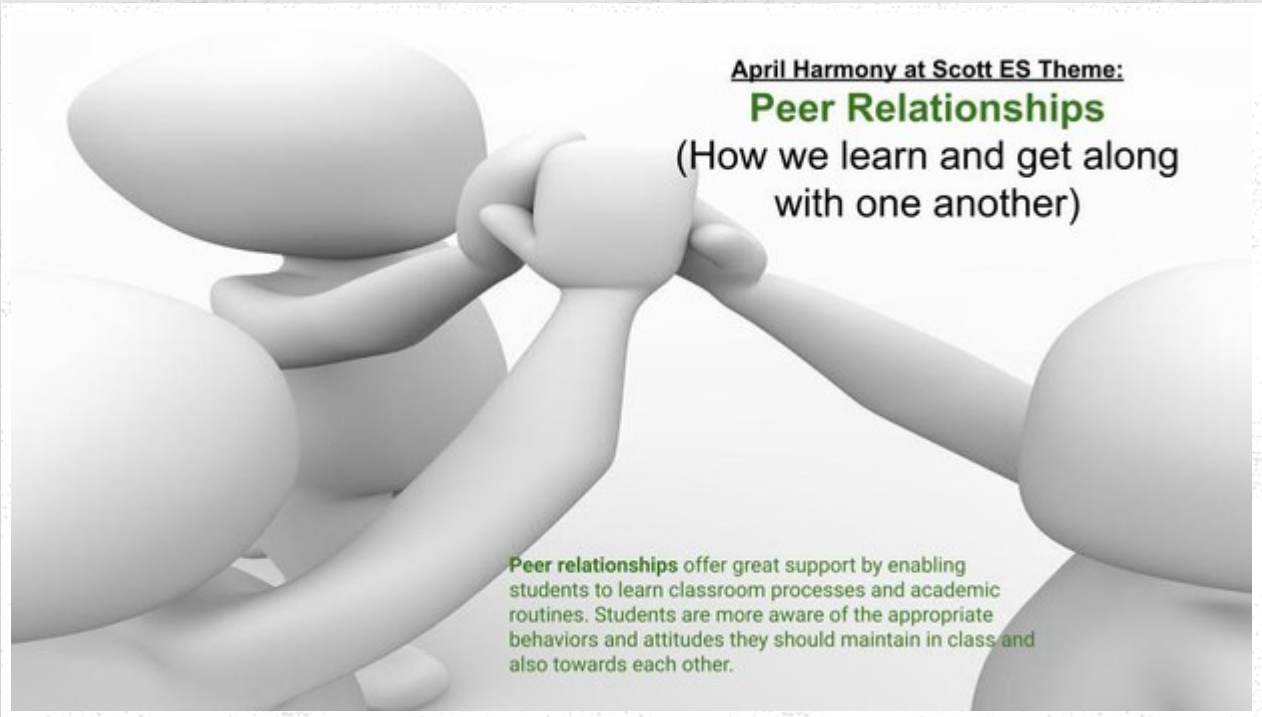

FOR ELEMENTARY SCHOOL LEARNERS IN GRADES K-2

Parents/guardians and elementary school students will want to thoroughly consider the expectations, supports, and schedule of a full-time distance education learner.

ATTENDANCE

Attendance is critical to distance education success. It is elementary school students' responsibility to:

- present/participate for an entire school day.
- The elementary school student must complete all assignments and participate in all activities.
- Complete learning management system assignments.
- The elementary school student participates in all the classes.

Students are required to attend weekly.

*Florida education statute is a chronic absence violation if a student is absent from school for 10 or more days in a school year. The Department of Education requires for the 2020-2021 school year.

COMMUNICATION

Two-way communication with the elementary school student's teacher is essential. Each teacher and

parent/guardian will be responsible to monitor and establish user after hours hours. 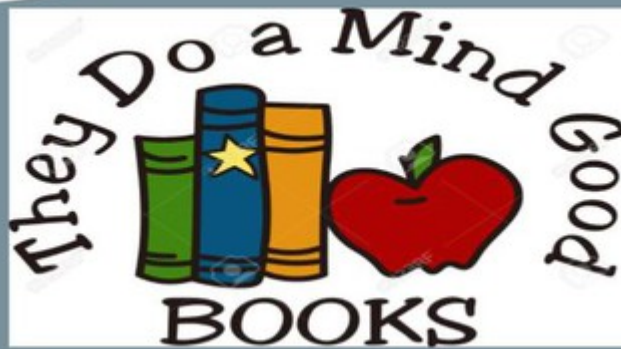


Reading Rocks at Scott ES!
